

Fun With Collage Materials List

Part of the fun of collage is *finding* the images, colors, pictures and materials that appeal to you. To that end I suggest sorting, clipping and collecting images from magazines, scrapbooks, receipts, postcards and photographs and putting them into a large manila envelope before the first class. You can make color Xeroxes or use scans of precious pictures if you do not want to destroy the originals.

Must have:

Scissors

White Glue – Tacky or Sobo glue dry faster than Elmer's but results are generally similar if you apply pressure to piece after class

Q-tips are nice to spread glue

Optional Items to bring:

Straight edge and/or ruler

Natural materials like dried leaves, petals, feathers etc.

Unique papers – can be tissue, wallpaper, gift wrap or specialty types from art store

Fabrics – ironed work best Also ribbon, sequins, ric rac, and other trims

Unique hole punches and/or rubber stamps and ink pads

Colored pencils

Glitter or glitter glue pens

Fabrics and lace

Old stamps

Pieces of poems or books that intrigue you

Specialty scissors like pinking, deckle edge etc.
