

QUILTING for BEGINNERS

- Sewing machine in good working order (bring to first class, but not necessary for every class), threaded with neutral thread (good quality, not bargain thread) medium gray or brown works best
- If possible, bring "attachments" or tool kit that comes with machine.
- Scissors
- Rotary supplies: ruler, mat, rotary scissors
- Extension cord
- Pins/pin cushion
- Pen or pencil and paper for notes
- Fabrics:
 - One yard "focus" fabric - usually a medium to large scale multi-colored print
 - 3 or 4 half-yard cuts of fabrics that coordinate with the focus fabric
 - One yard light colored background fabric
 - 1/4 - 1/2 yard scrap fabric for practice cutting if you are not familiar with rotary cutting.

Fabric selection will be easier if you go to one of the local quilt shops like Cottonweeds in Freeport or Mariner's Compass in Bath.

Look at the hanging quilt samples to get ideas and to see the combinations that are pleasing to you.
