Class 1: Free Motion Quilting

- Machine in good working order
- Free motion foot – also called a darning foot or embroidery foot
- Full bobbin, any color, color can contrast with fabric
- Top and bobbin thread should be good quality
- Two or more quilt “sandwiches” – batting piece layered between top and bottom fabric pieces. These can be any size. Fabric can be muslin or any 100% cotton fabric. Something plain will show the stitching better. Experimenting with different sizes and types of batting is ideal for this class. Optional: a small, finished quilt ready for quilting, or a 12” finished block.
- “Machingers” – quilting gloves that can be purchased at most quilt shops
- Sewing notions: scissors, pins, etc. Be sure to have extra machine needles, preferable a pack with different sizes.
